Guidelines to follow when transporting your tires to your nearest disposal site:

Remove rims from all tires before drop-off.
Per California State law, transport up to 9 tires per trip.
Only residential tires will be accepted free of charge.
No tires from waste tire generating businesses will be accepted.
All loads must be tarped or secured.
